

Will it pay off?

This is the first draft of a new small model of the Japanese Nissan. The car has been identified as a vehicle for global reach. Baby is slated for release in March next year.

Everything seems to indicate that the car will be succeeded by the current generation of Micra, known to the Japanese market, as March. The car first hit the showrooms in Thailand. This will happen in March 2010. After the Asian premiere of the new Micra is expected to be 150 other countries.
