

## Mitsubishi i-MiEV for policemen

Been used in garbage collection trucks, waste compactors are powered by internal combustion engine vehicle. This means that the garbage collection and landing, the engine must always work, increasing noise and pollution. Organic garbage is quieter and emit during operation by 75 percent. less carbon dioxide, so that the engine does not need to be constantly switched on during operation. Thanks to minimize noise, garbage trucks, such are the perfect solution when working in the early morning hours. In addition, the vehicle operating costs are lower, so that electricity is cheaper than diesel.
