

Chevrolet Police

V8 engine under the bonnet and the power of 355 hp, a new Chevrolet Caprice. This car since 2011. will move the American police.

Chevrolet Caprice police PPV (Police Patrol Vehicle) will be produced by Australian company Holden - owned by General Motors. Car body refers to the Pontiac G8, and the floor pan was developed based on Zeta platform, General Motors, used also in the new Chevrolet Camaro. Baby will be modified specifically for the police. Will be equipped with special lighting, reinforced windows and locks. Chevy police will also be offered an unbranded version. The new Caprice will move to 18-inch steel rims. The car will be equipped with high-performance alternator, good quality engine oil, and a very good system for transmitting power and cooling. In addition to the driver's disposal will be developed for the control center and the police vehicle information center.

Caprice PPV will be driven by 8-cylinder engine with a capacity of 6.0 l rear-wheel drive. The car will develop the power of 355 hp and its torque will be 521 Nm. Power is transferred via 6-speed automatic transmission specially calibrated for the police. General Motors says the car will be the first to disperse hundreds in less than 6 seconds. Since 2012. production has come Caprice V6 powered unit.
